The City of Modesto plans to modify and improve the SR-99/Pelandale Avenue Interchange to preempt degradation of traffic operations within the 20-year design period (2035). The acceptable Level of Service (LOS) for the project is LOS D. The project is designed such that it will not preclude the planned ultimate widening of SR-99 or future interchange improvements.

The project completely reconstructs the obsolete Pelandale Avenue interchange.

The Pelandale Avenue Interchange project is the largest transportation project in City history, one that the regions commuters, agricultural operations, and business owners are anxious to have bring much needed relief to one of the largest economic engines in the Central Valley.

The project serves major high-density commercial and service uses to the east and major agricultural centers to the west.
